NOTICE

Wet well levels at Goodworth Clatford Station Wastewater Pumping Station remain high, preventing Southern Water from carrying out critical work to repair nine leaking lateral drains in the vicinity.

They also wish to repair 58 metres of trunk sewer near to the Station. The company will now drain down the system by using tankers, ensuring that their customers' wastewater facilities are maintained and repairs can take place. This is preferable to over-pumping wastewater into the river. They apologise for any noise or disruption this may cause in the village which should be minimal and for a short period only.

This solution is the least disruptive and most environmentally friendly. The Parish Council is investigating why groundwater levels remain high at the north end of the village while not causing a problem elsewhere.
